Dr. Abhay Deshpande

Professor at SUNY Stonybrook & Director of EIC Science at BNL

Prof. Abhay Deshpande works in experimental nuclear and high energy physics. His research includes various exploratory and precision studies in QCD using polarized proton-proton, proton-nucleus and nucleus-nucleus beams of the Relativistic Heavy Ion Collider at BNL; and high intensity polarized electron beams of the recently upgraded JLAB facility in Newport News, Virginia. He is deeply involved with the development of the science and promotion of the future Electron Ion Collider.

- RIKEN BNL Research Center Fellow (2000-2007) (now Sr. Fellow)
- Director of Undergraduate Studies, Physics & Astronomy (2010-2014)
- Director of EIC Science & Director of the newly created SBU/BNL Center for Frontiers in Nuclear Science.
- 350+ Publications

His activities have focused on understanding QCD by probing the momentum and spin structure of the proton in terms of its fundamental components (quarks and gluons) and their dynamics. Abhay has performed experiments at CERN (Spin Muon Collaboration), at DESY (ZEUS), and BNL (RHIC/PHENIX/proton-polarimetry).

BNL LD-16 Committee Handbook - AGS/RHIC Users Executive Committee

The Group's purpose is to provide an organized channel for the interchange of information between the Laboratory administration and those who use BNL's nuclear, high-energy, and heavy-ion, radiobiological, and testing facilities. Representing a wide spectrum of research workers, the group will make known to the BNL administration the needs and desires of those actively engaged in leading research projects, while providing a means for BNL to inform them of current and future plans for the Laboratory. It is expected that this will enable the Laboratory administration better to evaluate the needs of its users' so they can more efficiently plan their use of Laboratory facilities.

Our primary purpose is to communicate important issues to lab management, and vice-versa. BNL is a User Facility and so Users and Management need to communicate constructively in order to ensure a successful laboratory.

Funding, Politics and Programmatics



- We invented several new activities last year
 - They have tremendous merit and I would like to propose that we pursue them again this year
 - 1. Letter to Congress
 - A letter to our congressional representatives recommending robust support for Science Funding
 - Authors to be solicited at the AUM the timing is perfect

Perhaps Justin + Volunteer can draft a template & report back in 2 months

- 2. Recommend a slate of Candidate for the APS/DNP Executive Committee
 - Ask RHIC Users to send nominations to DNP Nominating Committee
 - Slate of candidates to be selected by UEC, and signatures solicited at AUM. Again, the timing is perfect ... due by July 1st.

Two Volunteers (raise your hand) to evaluate past candidates and past winners to tell us what to look for in a candidate. See DNP newsletters. Report back to the UEC in 2 months time.

Washington DC: lobbying Congress



- Lobbying Congress on behalf of the RHIC & AGS facilities, but also all of Nuclear Science
 - A trip to DC in April or May
 - We never criticize another facility, but we do speak to our representatives about the importance of Nuclear Science to the economy and the Nation.
 - We try to visit as many RHIC & AGS Congressional Delegations as possible
 - All UEC members are welcome and encouraged to attend
 - This is a private trip (i.e. you pay) because this is actual lobbying and we can't use government resources to pay for the trip. In fact, I shouldn't even be showing you this slide :-)
- This is a very important activity ... it does make a difference
 - Please send you private (non-governmental) email address to Kelly and Jim so we can communicate with you.

Open Forums



- We conduct an open forum twice a year: at the Fall DNP Meeting and at the Annual Users Meeting
 - The goal is to hear directly from Users regarding issues that affect User research & productivity while using BNL facilities
- The Fall DNP Meeting is held in October
 - We usually have a brief professional meeting and dinner/social in conjunction with the Open Forum
 - Rosi has all the details
- The Annual Users Meeting is held in June

Communication with BNL Management



- For the past several years, Kathy has done an outstanding job of organizing monthly meetings with BNL Management
 - RHIC and Light Source Chair's attending
- We should keep doing that ... if she has the energy to continue organizing those meetings
