
Cafe Update

At the end of last episode

- Cafe has always been subsidized by BNL, and lab was willing to pay several thousand dollars to keep Cafe open.
- Analysis of the receipts found that the earliest and latest times were not bringing in much revenue
 - Hours shortened several months ago, to 7am-5pm, and prices increased by 10%



As of yesterday

• From Jeff: May and June were <u>profitable</u>, with a huge spike in revenue in June. But 7-8am & 4-5pm are still 20% of peak.

January **\$965.** loss **\$600.** loss **February** March **\$315.** profit Three month subsidy to BSA \$1,251 **\$250.** loss April May **\$252.** profit June **\$978.** profit Three month subsidy to BSA \$0

- \$2500-3000/year should be no problem for BSA
- But we should not be complacent -- should aim for no subsidy!
