  - At S&T we learned that House and Senate passed bills for DOE office of science not as good as President's original request for Nuclear Physics Office
    - DNP did a mailing and letter campaign

    - Mixed bag bottom line similar but unfunded add ons removed
    - Probably means 20-25 weeks in run 10
