- Festival 10/10/10- 10/24/10. Expo 23-24 on National Mall. Expect ~400 exhibitors
- Each is 10x10 tent (+table, 2 chairs, one outlet), hands-on exhibit for 10th grade or lower, scientists present. Cost \$250. Need to provide:
 1. A one-two line fun and "punchy" description and title of your exhibit and/or performance (See examples below),
 2. A vector graphic quality logo of your organization
 3. A high resolution candid picture from a past related event we could include in our brochure and website next to your description.
